
Earthworm castings are fertilizer for vegetables and fruit trees!

WORM BIN: A HABITAT FOR EARTHWORMS



What is a habitat?

A HABITAT PROVIDES LIVING CREATURES WITH... SHELTER WATER AIR FOOD

Are we giving our earthworms a good HABITAT?

What kind of habitat do earthworms need?

SHELTER: Cool temperatures, shade, loose soil, and protection from predators



WATER : Moist soil... but not wet! Earthworms breath through their moist skin... if the soil is too wet, they can't breath and they die.





AIR : Specifically, OXYGEN. Earthworms breathe through their skin. Loose soil allows the worms to breathe and move around to get oxygen.

FOOD: Old fruits, veggies, tea bags, and egg shells... things we usually throw in the trash.





We know we are giving the earthworms a good habitat by checking:

- TEMPERATURE- Between 50-70 degrees Fahrenheit is best.
- MOISTURE LEVEL Moist, but not wet!
- AMOUNT OF FOOD Not enough food and the worms won't have enough to eat. Too much food and it goes uneaten and attracts insects.


